

Homework



Homework will be sent home most evenings. Your child will have approximately 20 -30 minutes of homework Monday through Thursday. Please let me know if your child is having difficulty with homework assignments, I will be checking for any questions or comments about homework. There is a plastic pocket at the front of the agenda be sure to check the pocket for any additional notices that may be sent home. As well place any notes, forms etc. in the pocket, students will be checking the pocket each morning. I will be collecting and checking the homework on Fridays.

Music & Phys. Ed.

We will have 2 Music classes along with 3 Physical Education classes per week. Music Classes taught by Mrs. Henry will take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Phys. Ed., also taught by Mrs. Henry will be on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Transportation

Students who require a change in their after school plans (ie. Going to a babysitter's), must complete a request for bussing to an alternate address form. Forms are available at the school or our website. If there is an emergency, and a change must be made, please contact the school as soon as possible. If your child has a rotating schedule for after school transportation please send a note.

If you are dropping your child off in the morning, the drop off zone is just past the main lobby doors. Students will then walk along the sidewalk to the Hawk's Nest playground for morning recess. In the case that students are already inside, the lobby door will be used to enter the school. Please have your child dress for the weather, as we do go out in light rain. It is always a good idea to keep an extra change of clothes and socks, in your child's backpack or at school just in case, and to put your child's name on clothing, lunch bags, mittens etc.
