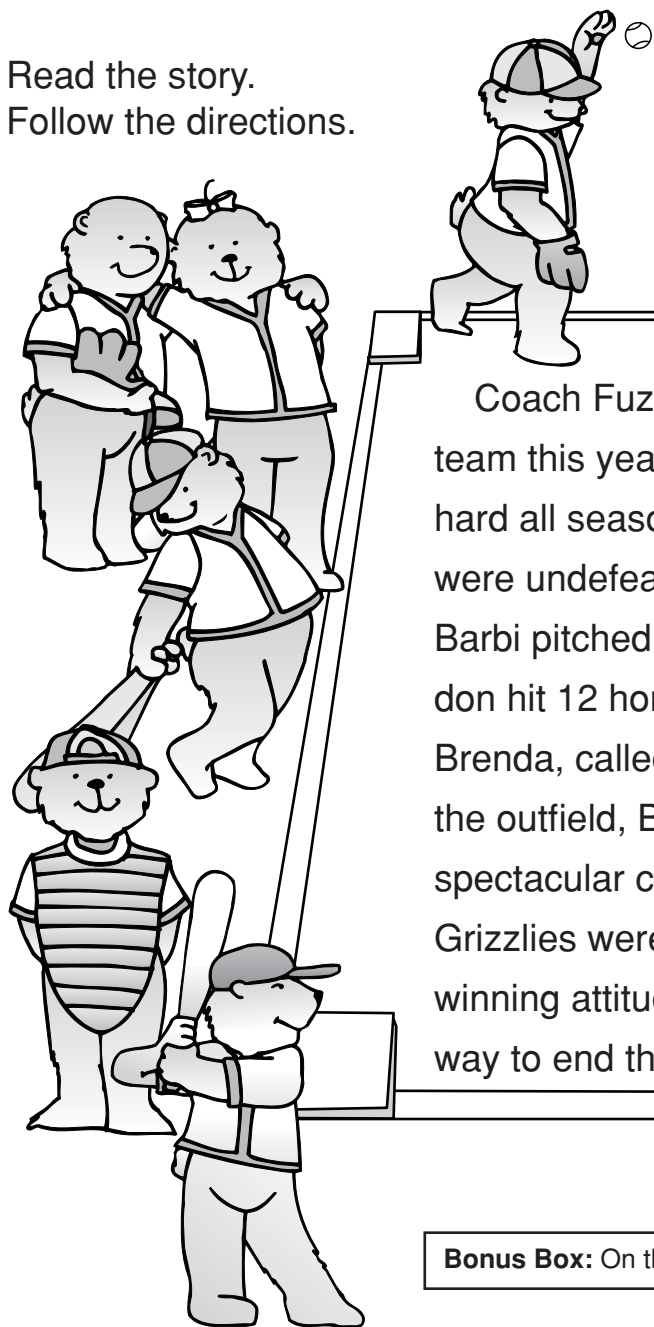
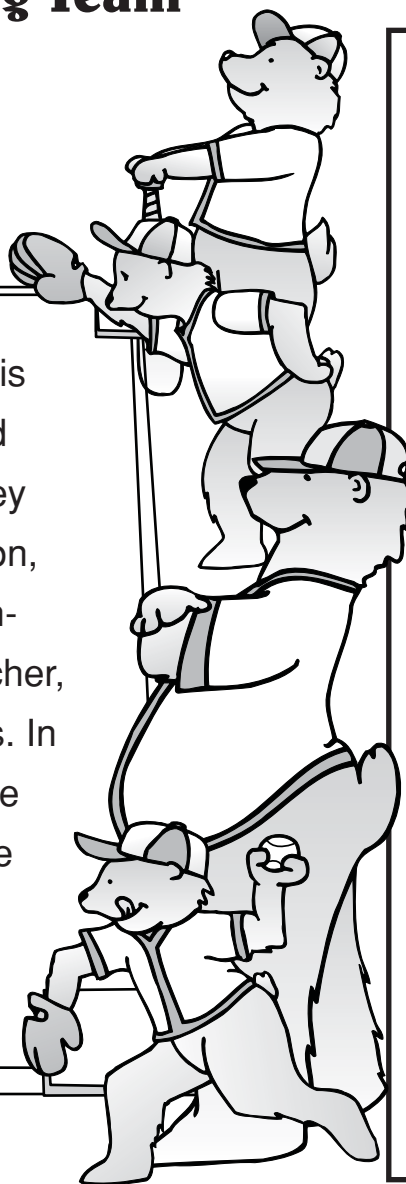


## A Winning Team








Read the story.
